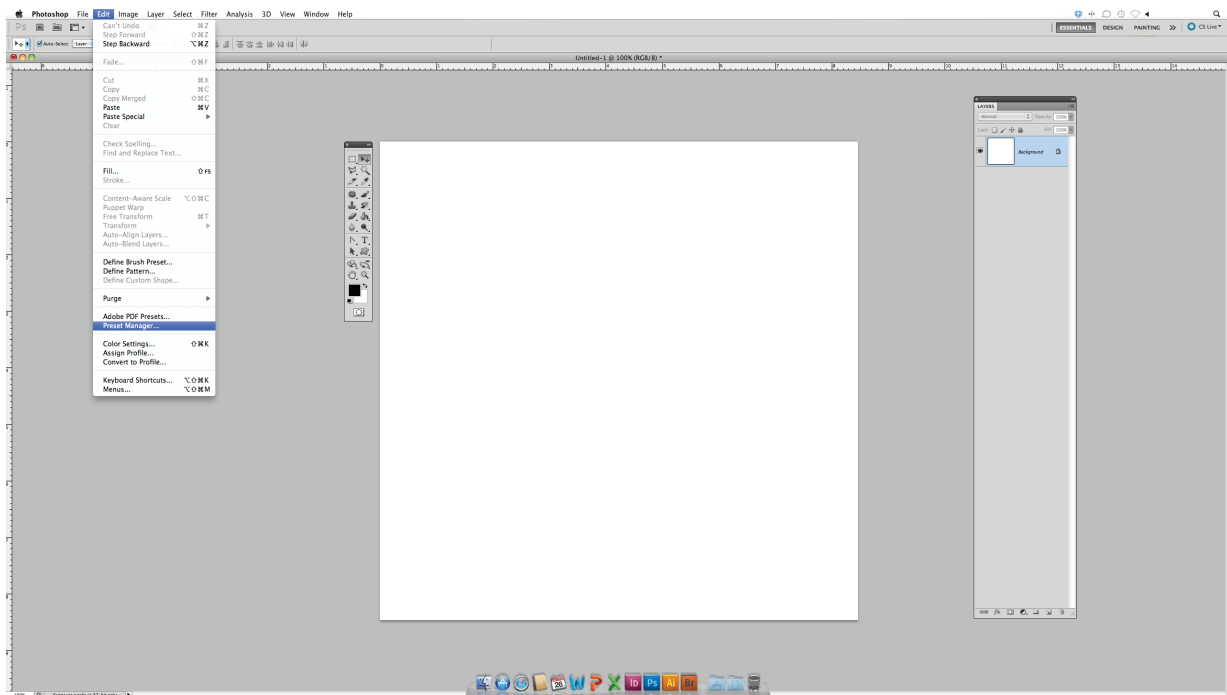


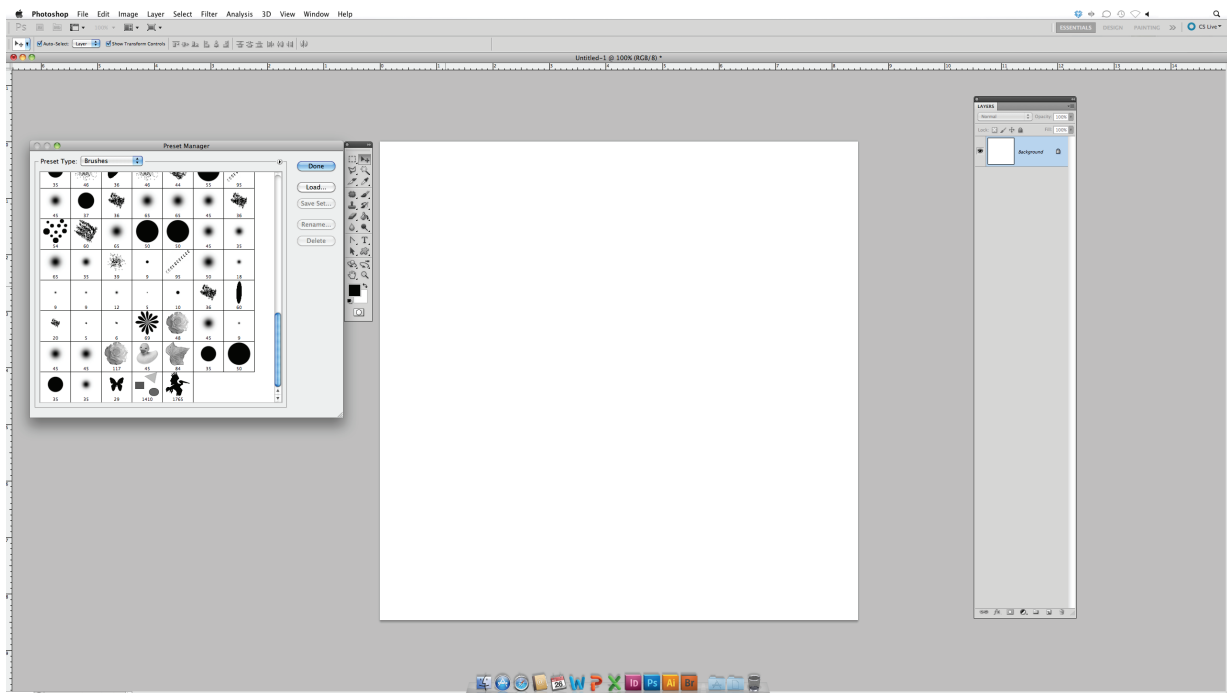
# BROKEN GLASS BRUSH HELP FILE

This Broken Glass Brush Help file try to help you how to load and use the brush on your Adobe Photoshop.

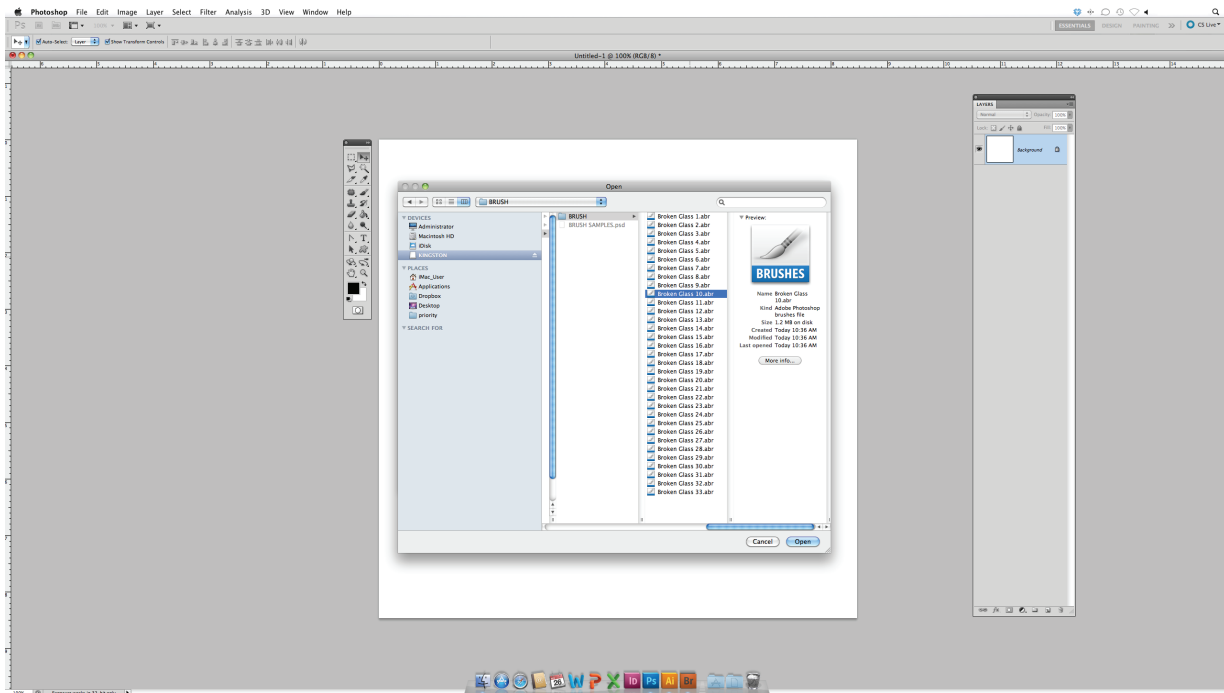
## A. LOAD THE BRUSH



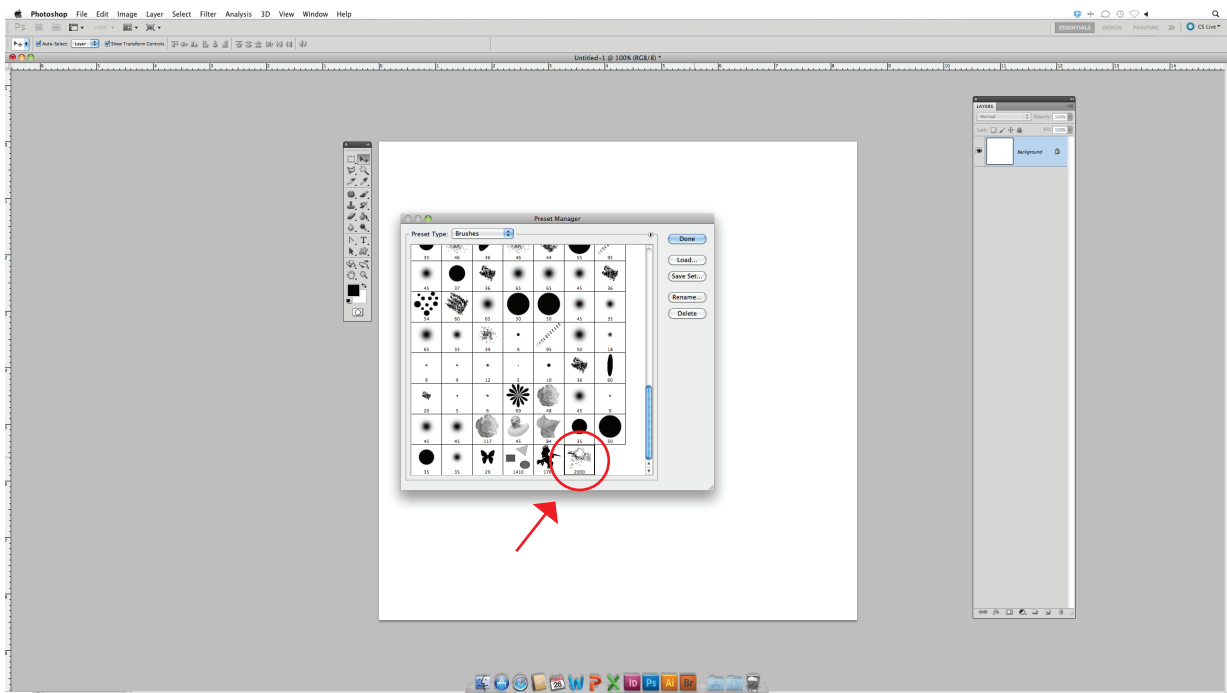
1. On Photoshop panel choose 'Edit' > 'Present Manager'



2. You will see pop up of Present Manager then click the 'Load' button

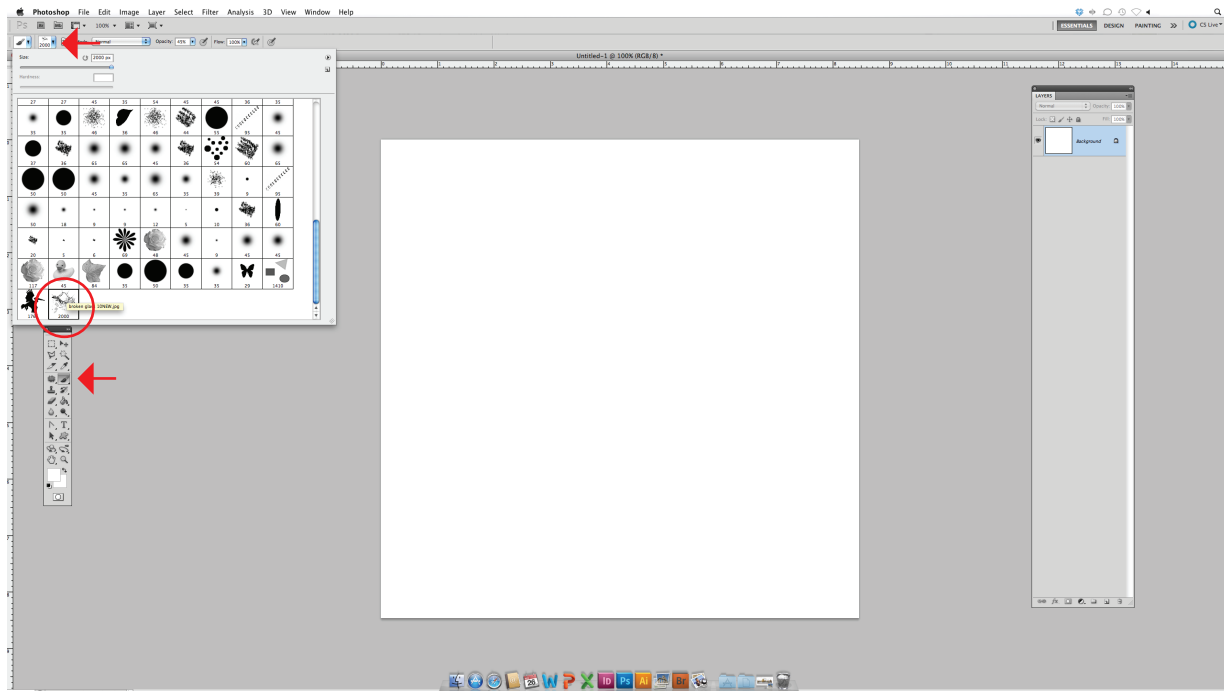


3. Choose the brush then click 'Open' button.

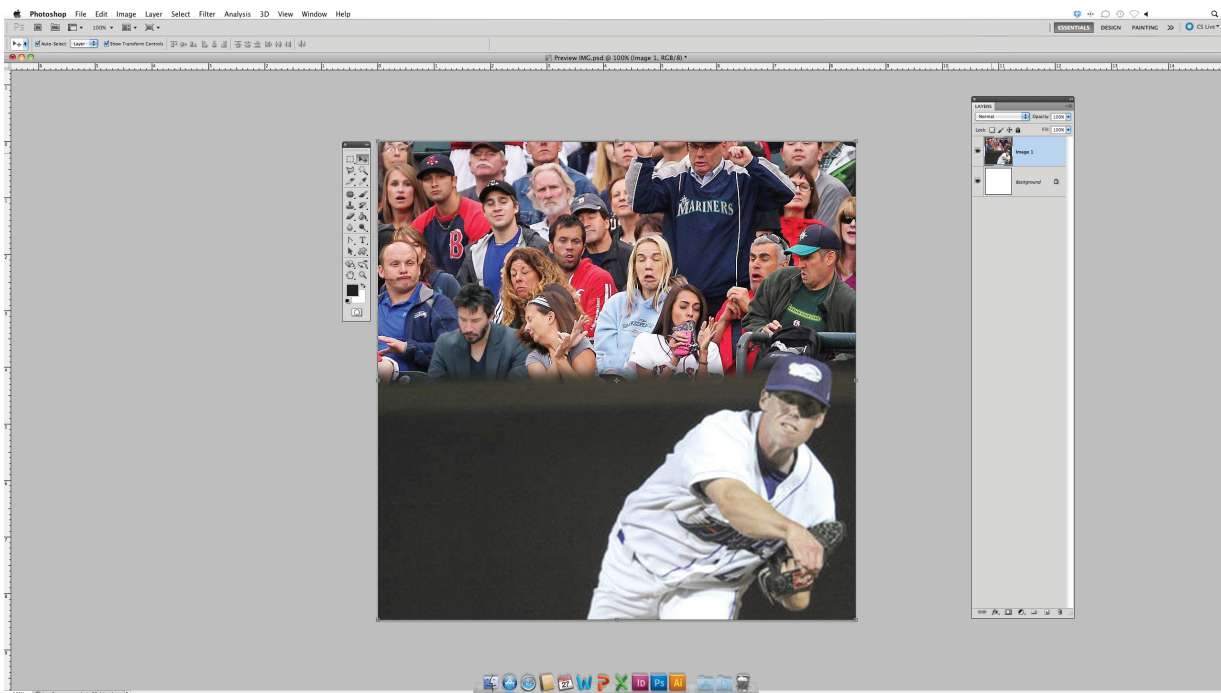


4. You will see the brush that you have been loaded in Present Manager then click 'Done' button

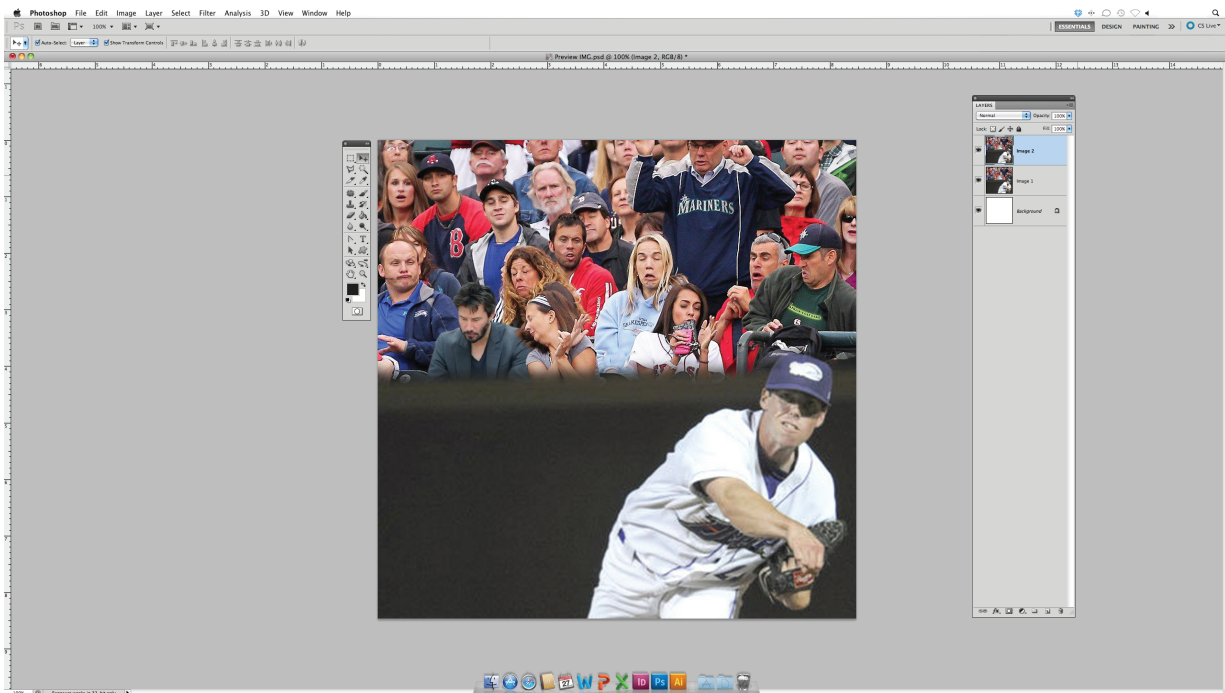
## B. USE THE BRUSH



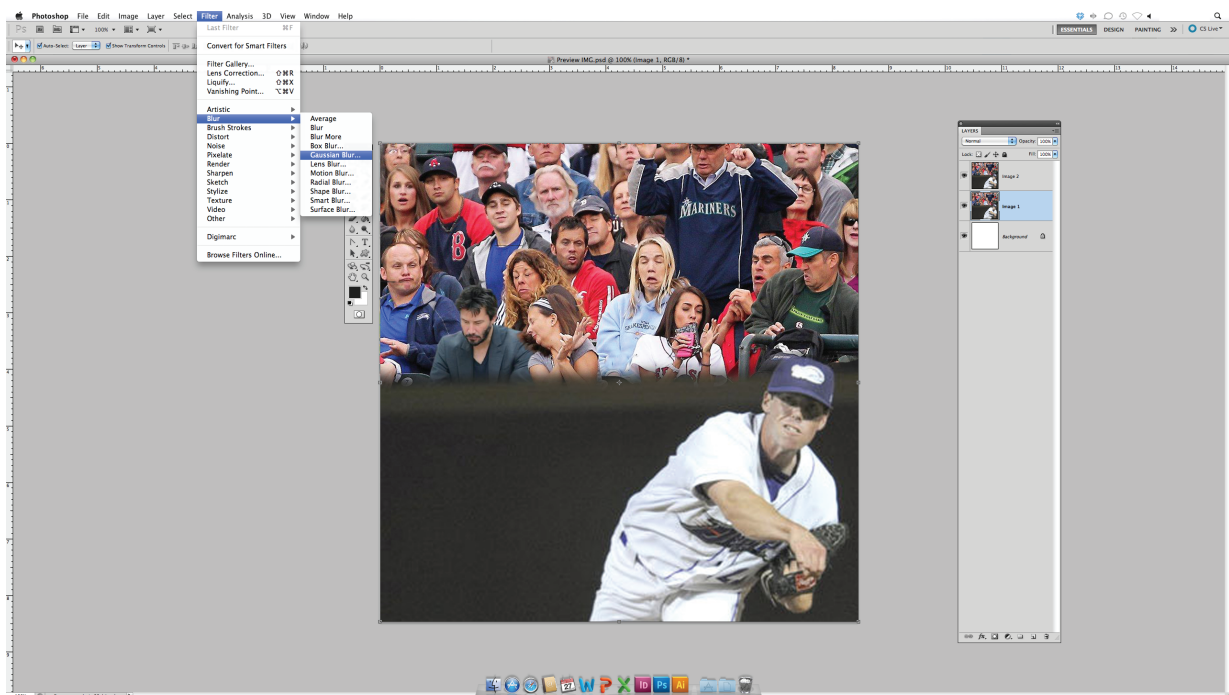
1. Check your brush with click the brush symbol in Tool panel, then click in brush roll on menu, you will the brush ready to use.



2. First, place your background image, named as 'image 1'

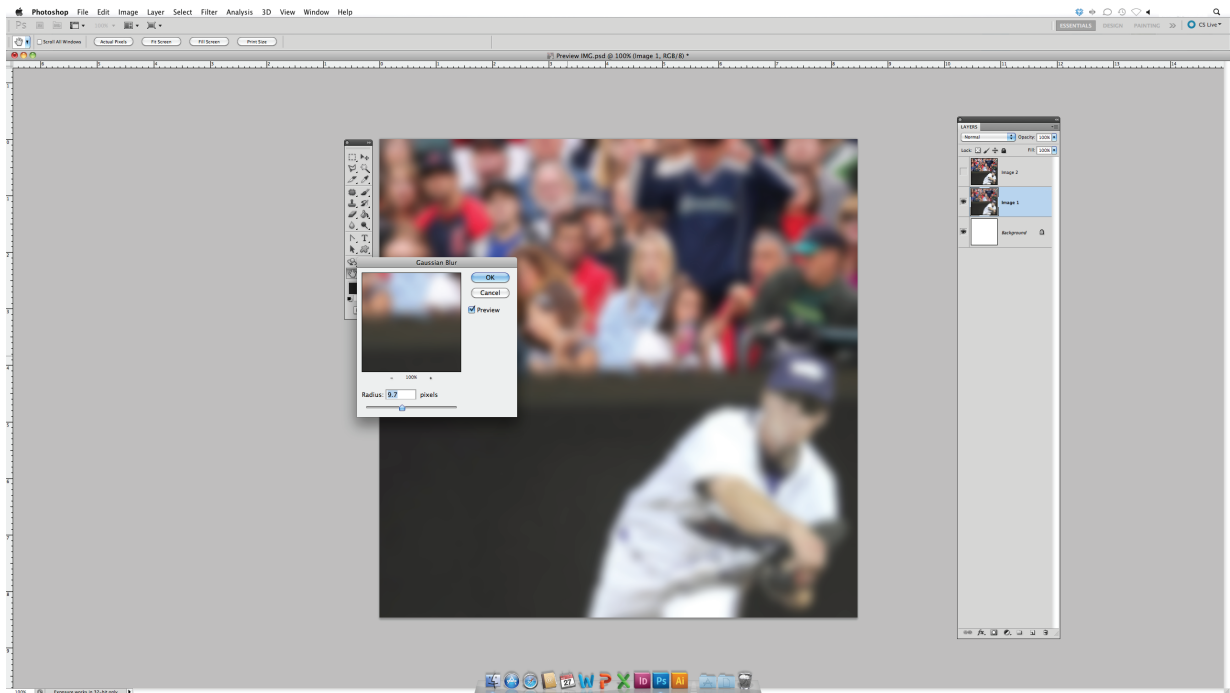


3. Duplicate 'image 1' then named 'image 2'

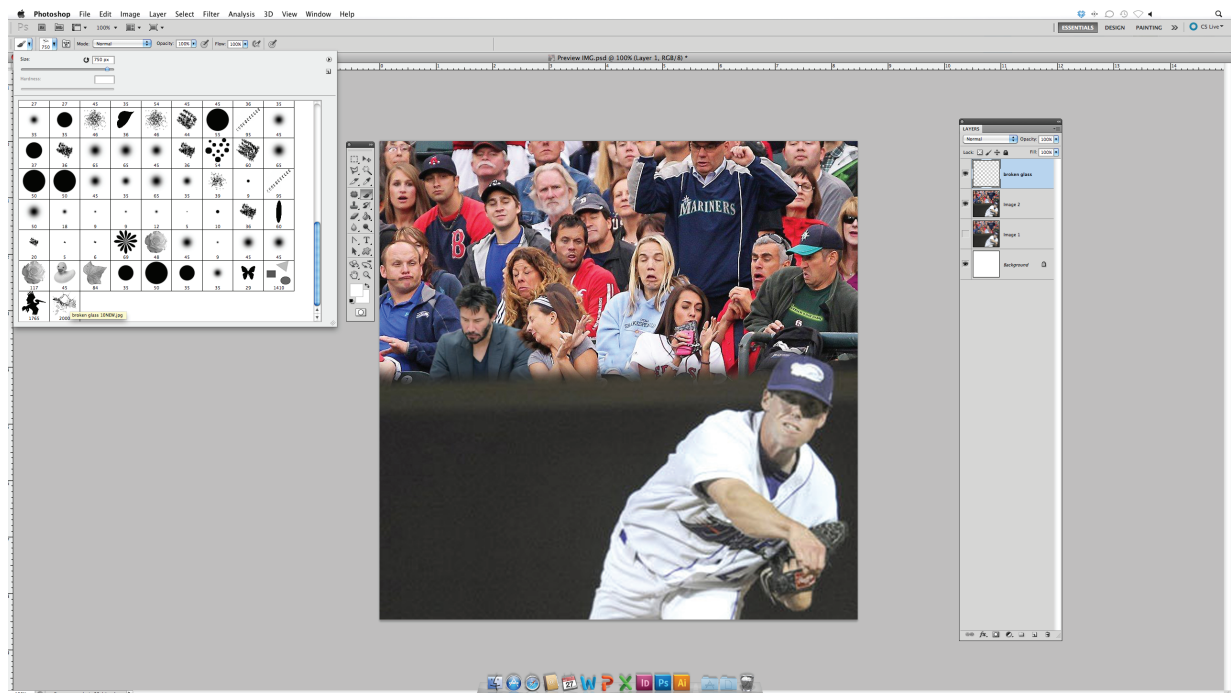


4. Select layer 'image 1' to make it blur. On Photoshop panel choose 'Filter' > 'Blur' > 'Gaussian Blur'

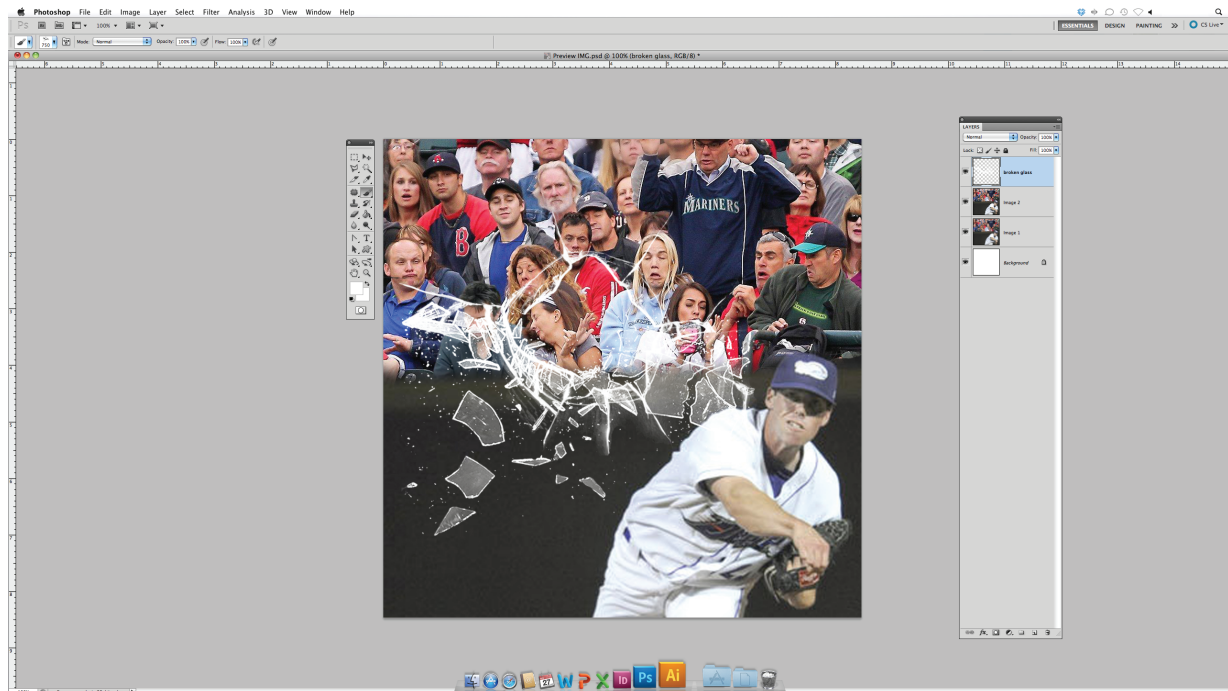




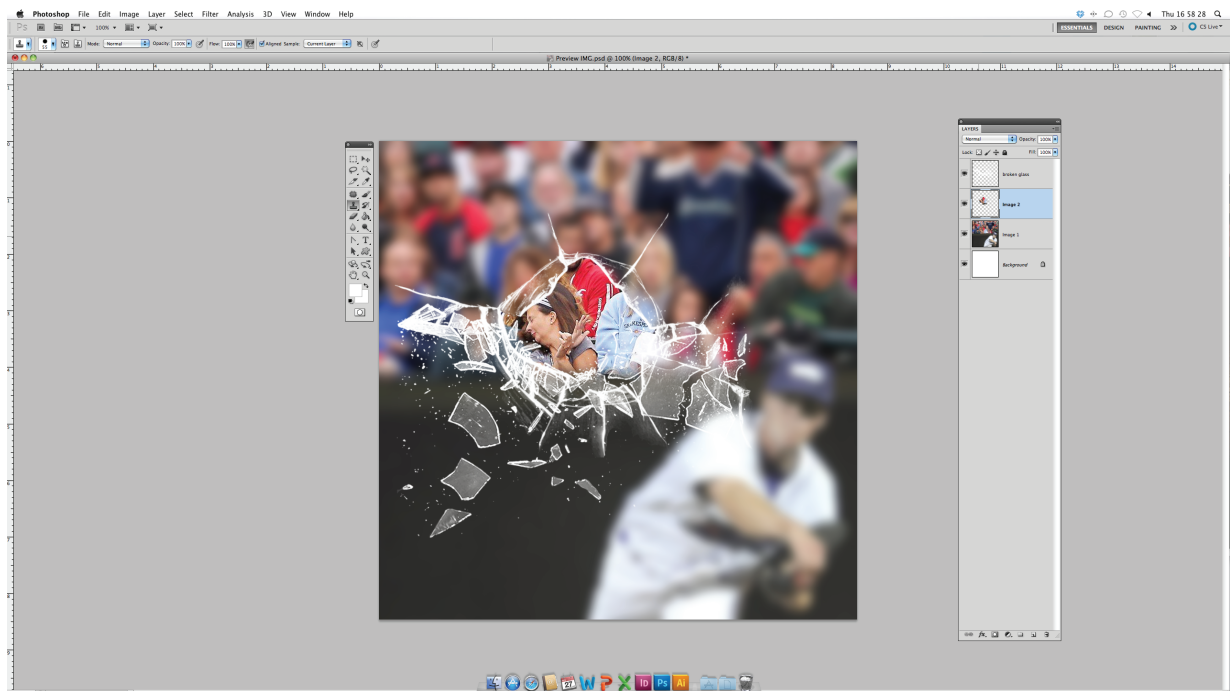
5. Choose radius to blur the image



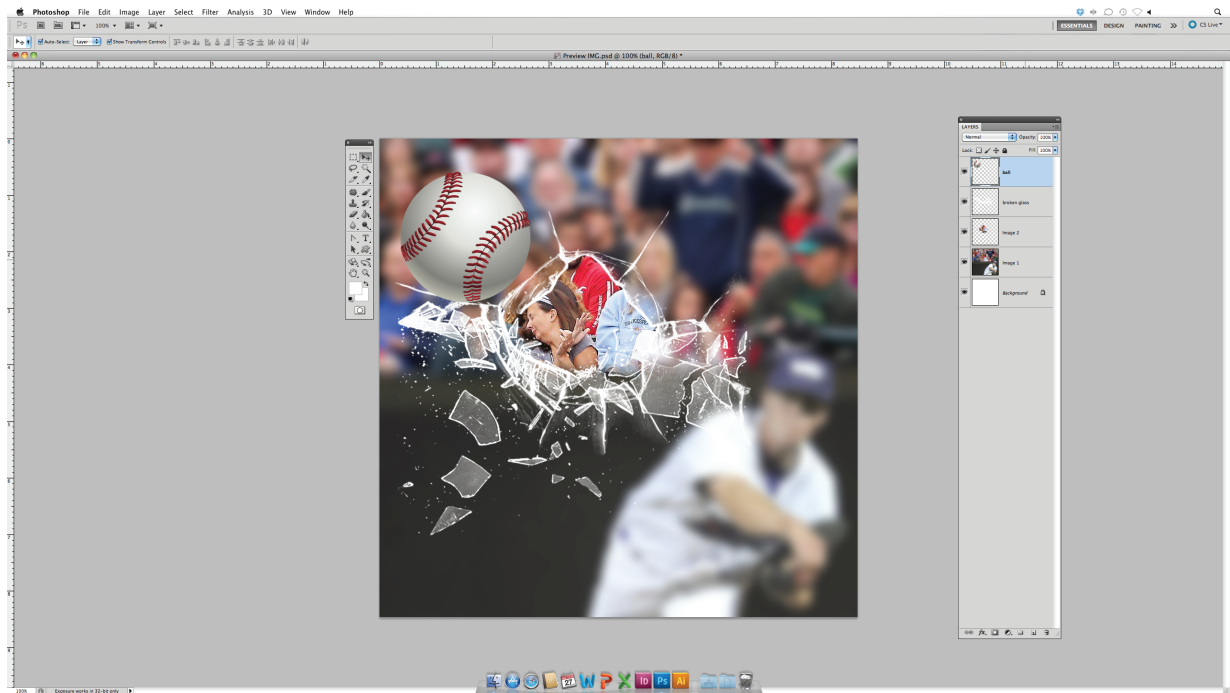
6. Make new layer then named as 'broken brush' then choose the brush on brush roll on panel



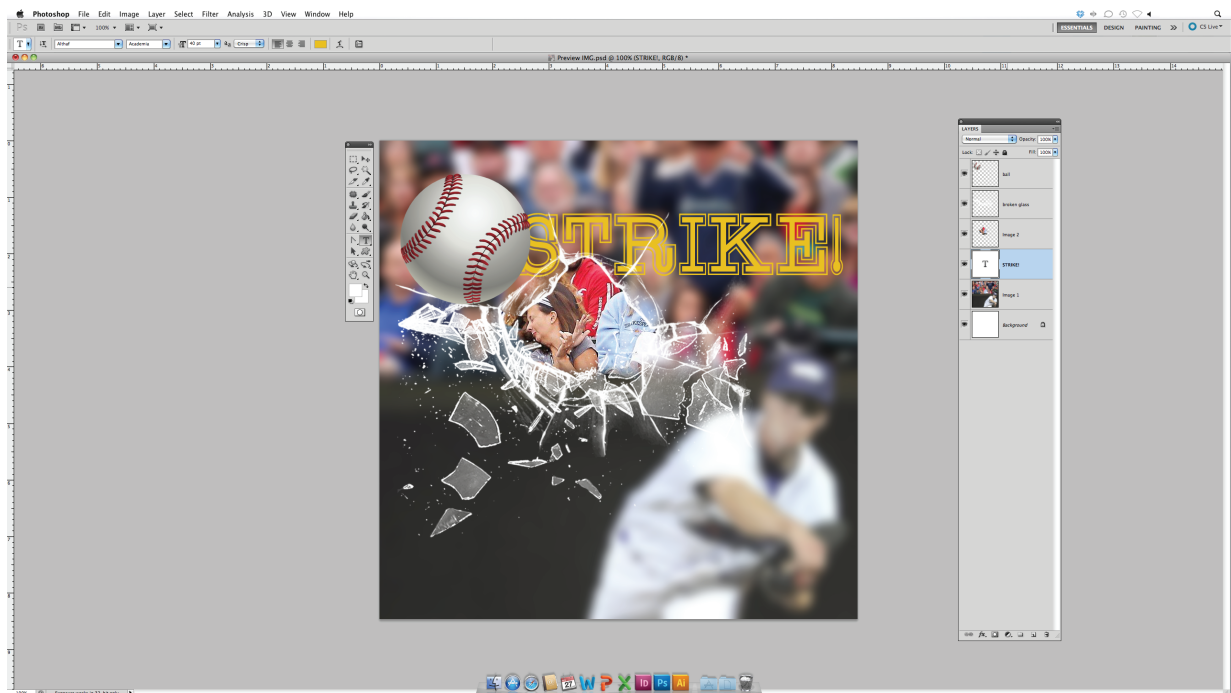
7. Put your brush where ever you want



8. Then select layer 'image 2' and erase all part of the image outside the hole of the broken glass



9. Make new layer and named as 'Ball' then put your ball image there



10. Finally, if you want put some text, make new layer below 'image 2' layer then type your text. That's it! I hope this tutorial very helpfull...enjoy!
